**2021 WAS THE 9<sup>TH</sup> CONSECUTIVE YEAR THE CATHOLIC CHARITIES APPEAL RAISED MORE THAN \$10,000,000!**

## FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

### CCA Special Initiatives

Nutritional Development Services (NDS) has been a critical program as more people and children than ever were in need of food and food-related resources. NDS stepped up and expanded its services to reach as many of our community members who needed help. **We are grateful to report that \$384,086 was raised from 5,133 gifts during the special and vital initiative with the CCA and NDS during the Thanksgiving season.**

The three Schools of Special Education within the Archdiocese of Philadelphia provide specialized care for God's most vulnerable children. **Thanks to the kindness shown by our faithful donors, over \$295,186 was raised from more than 4,125 gifts.** This past year has been especially hard as there were many months of uncertainty. Your commitment to serve our Catholic Community put so many parents at ease knowing their children always received the highest level of care.

With so much fear in the hearts of our senior community, it was more crucial than ever to support programs like Catholic Housing and Community Services. This program provides seniors with housing options, meals, in-home support, mental health services, and so much more. **Our cherished seniors received \$295,507 from 3,453 gifts from our incredible donors like you.**

The Catholic Charities Appeal is committed to transparency and stewardship of your gifts. This is why we do our best to keep fundraising, administrative and investment fees low. With all expenditures included, the Appeal operates at an average efficiency of \$0.16 cents per dollar raised. As a recognized authority, the Better Business Bureau indicates that total fundraising expenses do not exceed \$0.35 cents per dollar raised. While the Catholic Charities Appeal's total costs are considerably below this benchmark, we continuously strive for additional fundraising efficiencies.

*The Catholic Charities Appeal is recognized as a non-profit institution. As such, all gifts are tax-deductible to the fullest extent allowed by law. It has its own Employer Identification Number (EIN) and receives a separate financial audit. The Archdiocese of Philadelphia affirms that no funds donated during this Appeal will be used to support the independent reconciliation and reparations program or associated expenses.*

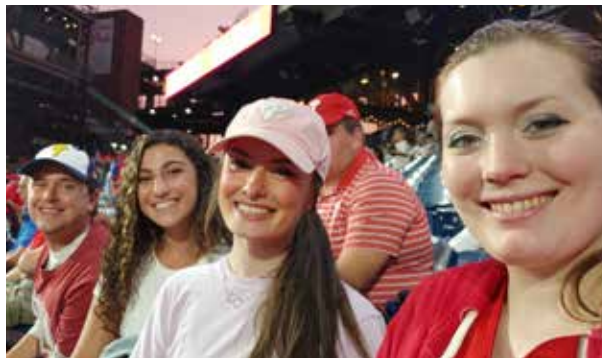




# EVENTS AND INITIATIVES

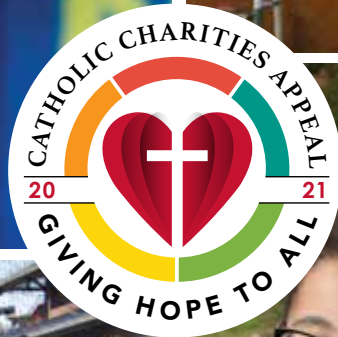
