

Available funds are distributed as follows:



#### **SOCIAL SERVICES: 54%**

Last year, nearly 610,000 people were positively impacted by the work of Catholic Social Services and Nutritional Development Services.

#### **EVANGELIZATION: 13%**

Countless lives are touched through support provided by various ministries within the Secretariat for Evangelization, including the Office for Life and Family, the Office for Cultural Ministries, and the Office for Persons with Disabilities.

#### **SPECIAL EDUCATION: 12%**

More than 100 students in the Schools of Special Education within the Archdiocese of Philadelphia receive tuition assistance and support.

#### **MISSION PARISHES: 11%**

Mission Parishes in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia are revitalizing and sustaining their community, including ministering to over 50,000 parishioners.

#### SICK AND RETIRED PRIESTS: 10%

There are currently 129 retired priests within the Archdiocese who count on the support of the CCA.

Social Services:

MARTHA'S CHOICE MARKETPLACE AND COMMUNITY FARM

"The person who waited on you at breakfast. The nurse who took care of your elderly mother. Your neighbor. All these people are clients at Martha's Choice Marketplace and Community Farm. These are people who are working every single day, but need to decide between paying their rent or putting healthy, nutritious food on the table That is where Martha's comes in. Martha's Choice Marketplace and Community Farm is the largest food pantry in Montgomery County. Last year, we distributed 2.3 million pounds of food to 4,000 different families. This equates to approximately 17,000 people - half of which are children. We recently acquired a farm, and we are now able to grow fresh produce for our clients. We have so many amazing volunteers who help us at

the farm – growing food items we would normally not have available at the pantry. It's a tremendous educational opportunity to make a connection with other people, and it brings our community together – to build something together that's going to be paying off for generations in the future. A significant portion of our funding comes from the Catholic Charities Appeal, and we are so grateful to all the donors who have supported us. You make this vital work possible."

ST. MARY'S RESIDENCE

"At the age of 77, I finally decided I didn't like living alone. That brought me to St. Mary's, one of the senior residences of Catholic Housing and Community Services. Thirty-seven women live here. We have meals together, pray the rosary, play games, watch movies and so much more - together. I have so many friends, and while independent, I still feel cared for. All the staff are so helpful and look after us ladies. Some of these women have nowhere else to go, no family to turn to. When you give to the Catholic Charities Appeal, you are keeping places like St. Mary's open so that people like me can have a safe place to call home."

He doesn't let his disabilities hold him back. Finn attends Our Lady of Confidence School, one of the three Schools of Special Education in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. I am a Catholic School teacher, so it was very important to my wife and I that Finn receives a Catholic education. Finn loves going to school every day. He and his classmates are treated with respect and dignity. It takes a special kind of person to dedicate their life to a mission, and that's what the school



provides. This is a welcoming, safe place that values our children. They deserve to have the best life possible because they are God's creation. The Catholic Charities Appeal makes all this possible. These children are not always given a fair chance, and by supporting the Appeal, you are providing them with a safe place to learn and grow in their Catholic faith."

Sick and Retired Priests: VILLA ST. JOSEPH

"I have been a priest for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia for 52 years and pastor at Saint Paul's Parish for 28 years. My parishioners mean so much to me; I consider them family. This is a vibrant parish where people live their sacraments every single day. Martha's Choice Marketplace and Farm is a great example: they are on our parish grounds, and I could not think of a better way to see people living out their faith and leading by example. I enjoy my active ministry, and as my retirement approaches, I am hoping to still be of assistance to any parish in need. If you ask any retired priest, the first thing they miss is the people. Many of my brother

priests live at Villa Saint Joseph. These are priests who have served you, the people of the Archdiocese, their whole lives. The Catholic Charities Appeal helps support retired priests - a beautiful gift and heartfelt sign of our appreciation to God for the gift of His priesthood. The Appeal allows each one of us to honor God with our whole heart. The Appeal gives us the ability to live the Mass, to live our faith."

- vangelization: DEAF APOSTOLATE

"My parents brought me to Church every Sunday when I was growing up; my mom would interpret the Mass for me in American Sign Language (ASL). I knew as a kid that I could be a Deacon and give back to the Church and the Deaf community. I have met several Deaf men who showed interest in becoming a Deacon, but they did not have the support of their dioceses. Fortunately, with the support of the Deaf Apostolate, I was able to discern my calling to become an ordained Deacon for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. The Deaf Apostolate provides pastoral care, sacramental preparation, religious education, and a regular schedule of Masses in ASL with the Catholic community who are Deaf or hard of hearing. Learning about your faith and not understanding what is being said is a challenge. Mass in ASL makes our faith visible in our own language – it gives our community access. We can process information more clearly when it's in our language. When you support the Catholic Charities Appeal, your donations help the Deaf community access their faith and participate in the Church."
