

## Social Services:

MARTHA'S CHOICE MARKETPLACE AND COMMUNITY FARM



"The person who waited on you at breakfast. The nurse who took care of your elderly mother. Your neighbor. All these people are clients at Martha's Choice Marketplace and Community Farm. These are people who are working every single day but need to decide between paying their rent or putting healthy, nutritious food on the table. That is where Martha's comes in. Martha's Choice Marketplace and Community Farm is the largest food pantry in Montgomery County. Last year, we distributed 2.3 million pounds of food to 4,000 different families. This equates to approximately 17,000 people – half of which are children. We recently acquired a farm, and we are now able to grow fresh produce for our clients. We have so many amazing volunteers who help us at the farm – growing food items we would normally not have available at the pantry. **A significant portion of our funding comes from the Catholic Charities Appeal, and we are so grateful to all the donors who have supported us. You make this vital work possible.**"
